



2019-2020 Academic Scholarship Instructions For Graduating High School Seniors from Collin or Denton Counties

Thank you for your interest in the OU Club of Collin County academic scholarship. Each year scholarships are awarded to deserving high school seniors from either Collin or Denton County that are bound for OU. The OU Club awards our scholarships based on the student's academic performance, extracurricular activities, leadership activities, articulation of goals and plans, as well as financial need.

This scholarship is awarded through the OU Foundation on behalf of the OU Club and is paid directly to the student's bursar account. After the bursar account is paid in full, any remaining funds will be distributed by the Office of the Bursar directly to the student. All funding is disbursed during the first week of each semester.

APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN FEBRUARY 10, 2019

INSTRUCTIONS

To apply for this year's scholarship:

1. For your application to be considered, you **must** meet the following criteria:
 - You must plan on attending OU fall of 2019
 - You must be a resident of Collin or Denton County
2. Fill out the attached application form completely using the interactive PDF interface. All answers **must** be typed. No exceptions. *(If necessary, you can download Adobe Reader here:* <https://get.adobe.com/reader>*)*

Please check that you are using the correct form. This form is for High School Students only. Please visit ouclubofcollincounty.com for the application for current College Students.)

3. Include your **certified or official** high school transcript. If you have attended more than one high school (10-12th grades), please provide certified or official transcripts from each high school attended.
4. Include two (2) letters of recommendation.
 - one must be from an academic teacher
 - one must be from a teacher or sponsor of an extracurricular activity

Each recommendation must be submitted in an envelope sealed by the writer to maintain confidentiality. (The applying student should NOT have access to read it.) The applicant must either forward sealed envelopes to the OU Club or ask the writer to mail their letter directly to the OU Club at the address below on your behalf.

5. Send your completed application, official transcript, and letters of recommendation to:

6. **Applications must be received by February 10, 2019.**



7. Interviews for the top candidates will be held **February 24, 2019**. If you are selected for an interview, you will be required to attend an interview session to be eligible to receive the scholarship.
8. We also would like to invite you to attend our Sooner Send-off towards the end of the spring semester. All future Sooners are invited to attend. And all scholarship recipients will be required to attend. *(Dates to be announced.)*

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If your application is incomplete, is received after the deadline, is missing any additional documents, or does not adhere to the above instructions, your application may not be considered.
